Editorial

It is the evening of April 27 as I type this and today marks the last day of New Zealand's Level 4 lockdown – a state the country has been in since 11.59pm on March 25. Tomorrow some sectors can start up again, albeit under some pretty strict criteria. There will still be no in-house dining for restaurants, no chance to head to the mall or the movies, hit the bars or attend stamp shows and the like – and New Zealand's borders remain closed to non residents. Our national airline Air New Zealand has had its flights reduced by 99% and is a mere skeleton of what it once was.

Here at Campbell Paterson, David and I are grateful for how our country has embraced the lockdown. At the time of writing we've had 1469 cases of which 1180 have recovered. Sadly there have been 19 deaths. Our Australian neighbours have also had very good results, for which we are also thankful. Our thoughts are very much with our clients, friends and colleagues in some of the many harder hit countries, especially Europe, the UK and the USA. There can be no doubt that New Zealand, along with the rest of the world, is likely in for some very tough economic times ahead in some industries but we feel confident that we will endure.

Some readers may have seen the positive article which appeared in The Guardian on Saturday April 11 entitled "Why millennials have fallen in love with stamp collecting". While specific detail is scant around how many, what and why millennials are collecting, the article is rich in quotes from mainly UK based philatelic dealers and auction houses rather than too many millennials themselves on how a younger generation are picking up and genuinely enjoying the hobby. I found it interesting to read the comments on what supposedly appealed to these younger collectors in the 30-39 age bracket. Comments such as

"Each stamp tells a story: I often like to think of the many hands they have passed through"

"I just collect what I like – stamps that tell stories or are graphically appealing" and "I have a scientific background, so the analytical side really appeals"

"My personal philatelic interest is crash mail, envelopes salvaged from plane crashes. Definitely morbid but equally fascinating."

While its common to hear dealers and collectors make comments around needing more ‘younger’ collectors it seems that they are out there and certainly in my view – they always have been. It is just a case of nurturing the interest and seeing where the newer interest leads and how it takes into account past knowledge and research. Whatever the direction New Zealand philately has so much to offer the collector be they millennial or someone a little older.

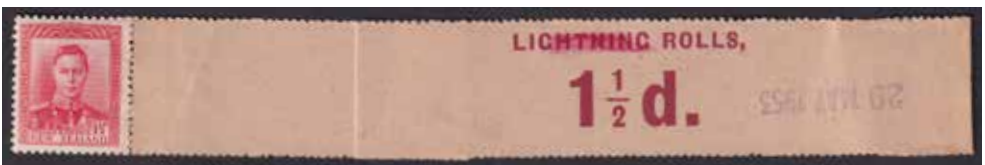

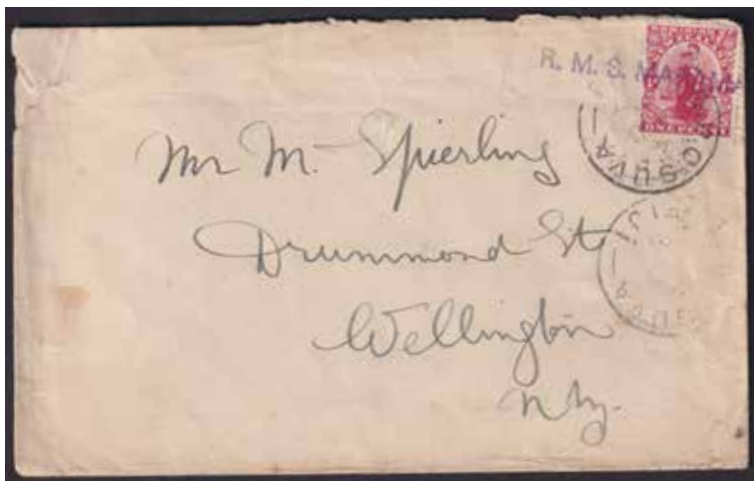
